



SIX NATIONS RUGBY AND FRANCE TELEVISIONS SET TO EXTEND THEIR PARTNERSHIP

- **Six Nations Rugby and France Televisions have confirmed an agreement in principle to the extension of their partnership**
- **The extension will encompass all Guinness Six Nations and TikTok Women's Championships matches from 2023 to 2025 inclusive**
- **The partnership will also ensure France Televisions can offer fans each of France Men's XV Autumn Nations Series 2022 fixtures**

Six Nations Rugby and France Televisions are set to continue their relationship, after agreeing an extension in principle, that will build on the current partnership.

The national French broadcaster will have exclusive rights to bring fans all fifteen Guinness Six Nations matches, and all fifteen TikTok Women's Six Nations fixtures from 2023 to 2025 inclusive. The partnership will also give France Televisions exclusive rights to show all three France Men's XV Autumn Nations Series games in 2022 featuring matches against Australia, South Africa and Japan.

Commenting on the partnership agreement, Ben Morel, CEO of Six Nations Rugby, said:

"France Televisions have been an incredible long-standing partner to the Six Nations. I look forward to continuing our successful partnership and bringing our men's and women's Championships to even greater heights"

Le diffuseur national français aura les droits exclusifs pour diffuser les 15 matchs du Tournoi des Six Nations et les 15 matchs du TikTok Tournoi des Six Nations féminin de 2023 à 2025 inclus. Ce partenariat donnera également les droits exclusifs à France Télévisions pour les trois matchs du XV de France masculin lors de l'Autumn Nations Series 2022 avec les matchs contre l'Australie, l'Afrique du Sud et le Japon.

En commentant l'accord, Ben Morel, le PDG de Six Nations Rugby, a dit :
